Dr. Victorio Oxilia Davalos (Paraguayan) is a BSc. in Physics from the University of Sao Paulo (Brazil) and has a Msc. in Social History of Science and Technology development and a PhD. in Energy from the University of Sao Paulo, Brazil. He also has a specialization in nuclear reactors physics in the Institute of Nuclear and Energy Research (IPEN) in Sao Paulo.

Regarding to his academic performance, Mr. Oxilia has been a professor and researcher at the National University of Asuncion, the Catholic University of Asuncion in Paraguay, and at the University of Sao Paulo in Brazil. He has published several articles in international journals and has co-authored books published in Sao Paulo, Brazil.

He has been advisor to the Minister of Industry and Commerce, Director of Energy and Director of Scientific Development of the Government of Paraguay. Mr. Oxilia has participated in the creation of international fora such as the Energy Working Subgroup of MERCOSUR and has been a delegate at OLADE's fora and Commissions, and at the Committee of Science and Technology of the Organization of American States and the United Nations.

He is Partner of a non profit organization in Paraguay (Energy Strategies for Sustainable Development-ESENERG), which has done several studies and energy projects for Latin American countries.

Mr. Oxilia has joined OLADE since 2008 where he has worked as a Training Coordinator. He was empowered to design and implement training programs for Member Countries of the Organization and to support formal education programs related to the purposes of OLADE. Starting March 2010, he has been appointed Director of the Department of Integration of OLADE.
